Subject: Updated COVID regulations.

Following the government's most recent announcement, from Thursday September 24th there are a few changes to the way we will operate both in the club, and specifically within the clubhouse.

Firstly, regulations now require that anybody entering the building for any reason wear a mask. This includes anyone just passing through. Once indoors masks are mandatory. You will be able to remove your mask only when you have been seated by a member of staff.

Secondly, we will be operating a "table service only", this means you should no longer go to the bar, instead, the bar (team) will come to you!

When you leave we ask that you take any tissues or napkins and deposit them in the bin by the exit, these are among the most high risk to spread the virus and by doing this you help minimise the potential exposure to the staff.

Where possible, we ask that members pay using their members discount card, and to reduce the time spent dealing with payments we would encourage members to top up at quieter periods.

Members and guests are encouraged to make use of the numerous hand sanitizing stations around the Club and Clubhouse.

Signing in manually when entering the Clubhouse will continue to be required. Over the coming days you may notice the QR Code posters for signing in with the NHS COVID-19 app, these will provide an alternative way for smart phone users to sign in once the app is up and running.
